In the afternoon, visit of the late Roman Villa of Tellaro, for the extraordinary polychrome mosaics. Return to the hotel for dinner

Thursday: breakfast and free morning. Free lunch. In the afternoon wine tasting at the renowned winery Felice Modica famous for the sweet wine Dolce Nero. Return to the hotel for dinner

Friday: breakfast and tour of the city Taormina; visit of the Greek Theater, lunch at popular restaurant. In the afternoon transfer to the volcano Etna. Return to the hotel for dinner

Saturday: breakfast and airport transfer
